2020 HIGHLIGHTS



JANUARY

KIDSPORT 25: 2020 marked our 25th year getting kids across Calgary & Area off the sidelines and into the game!

SPORTSNET 960 & OPA 5050: We teamed up with Sportsnet 960 The Fan and OPA! of Greece for our first ever Citywide 50/50 to raise funds So ALL Kids Can Play!

COACH THE COACH: The Calgary Hitmen helped us launch Coach The Coach – a fundraising campaign where teams could turn the tables and put their coach through their favorite (or least favorite) drills.

APRIL

KIDSPORT RECYCLING: With our community spending more time at home, we ramped up promotion of our recycling program via the continuation of our safe curbside pickups. Over 75 new households came on board in April.

MAY-JUNE

SUMMER EQUIPMENT: We partnered up with Youth Centres of Calgary to provide free lunches and equipment to families in 5 different areas of Calgary.

JULY

FLAMES FOUNDATION: Bill Comrie passed the torch to the Calgary Flames Foundation as they will now be the lead partner in supporting the Calgary Flames Sports Bank Team to get local kids in gear.

BACK TO SPORT: As sport began to make a return, we launched our Back To Sport program to help bring sport back to those kids in our community who needed it most.

SHAW CHARITY CLASSIC: The Shaw Charity Classic launched their #ChipinforKids text to give program to help get kids back in the game.

OCTOBER

PIZZA PIGOUT: We took our annual Eric Francis Pizza Pigout virtual in 2020! We were able to support our pizzerias, provide meals to 35 KidSport families, engage with over 100,000 people online, raise some funds, and vote on Calgary's Best Pizza!

FACE FIRST PODCAST: We were thrilled to launch our Face First Podcast thanks to the efforts of three of our great ambassadors Alysia Rissling, Rob Kerr and Grace Dafoe. Amazing guests and content with now over 18 podcasts available for you to check out.

NOVEMBER

TURKEY BOWL: The team at Iconic Electric and Controls came up with a new way to enjoy the annual Iconic Turkey Bowl virtually. We supported local businesses, raised some money for KidSport, and watched Football all from the comfort of our own couch.

DECEMBER

VIRTUAL HOT STOVE: Eric Francis and Rob Kerr hosted a YYC Charity Hot Stove with Brian Burke to get an inside look at his new book: Burke's Law – A Life in Hockey and to raise funds So ALL Kids Can Play.

WINTER EQUIPMENT: The Calgary Flames Sports Bank provided KidSport families with free skates to get families in need on the ice during the winter season! Over 200 kids got the chance to get out on the outdoor rinks this winter.


